The Balboa Park Tram is an intra-park transportation system provided to you as a free public service by the City of San Diego, Park and Recreation Department. ## Balboa Park Visitors Center - G-4

The primary source for up-to-date information about all the attractions in Balboa Park is the Visitors Center, centrally located in the lovely House of Hospitality. Knowledgeable volunteers are on hand to answer questions about the Park's many cultural organizations, the outstanding gardens and recreational opportunities. A handy, comprehensive Events Guide & Map is also available for a nominal charge. The Visitors Center also sells the Passport to Balboa Park, a discount museum admission booklet. 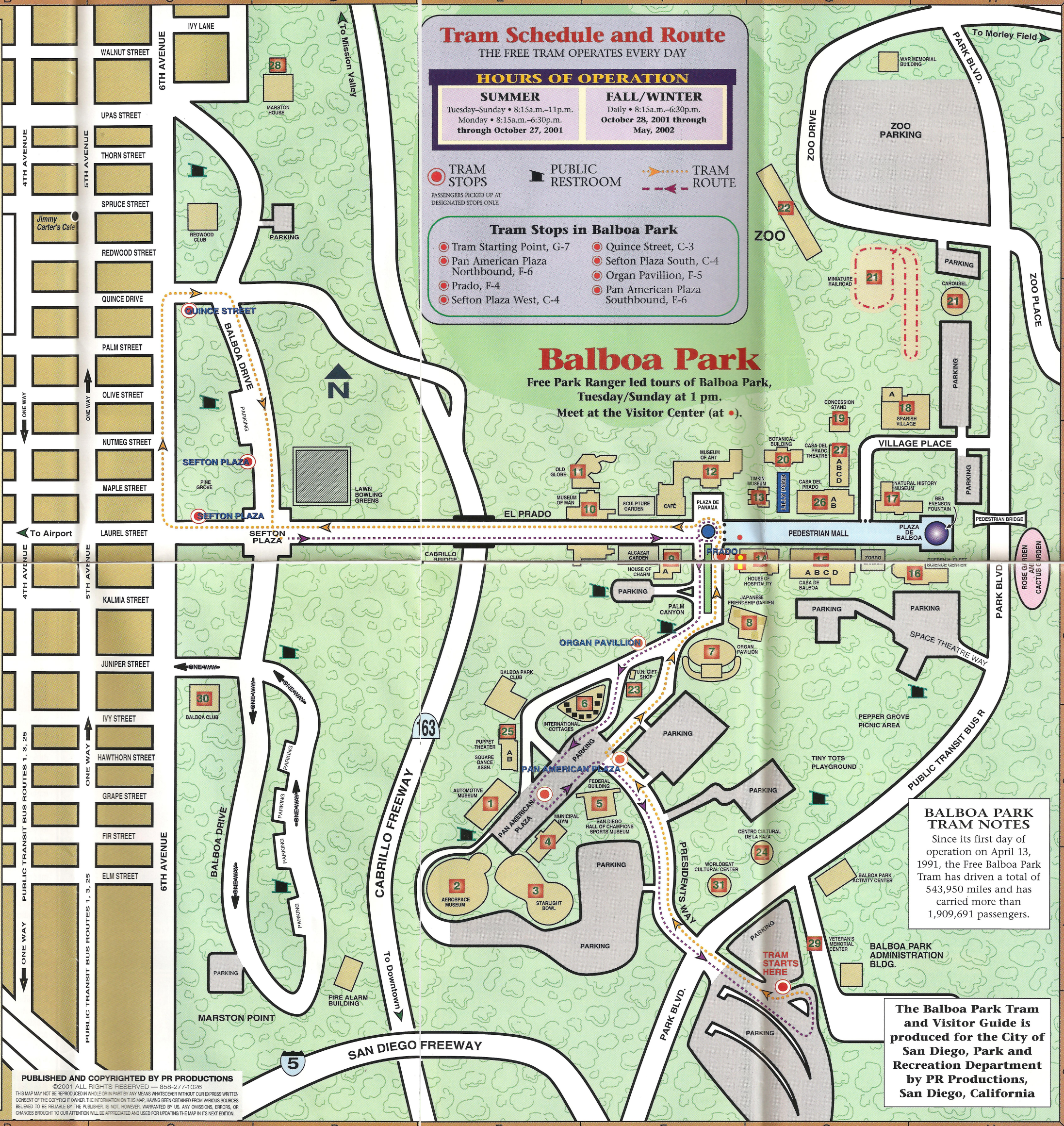
