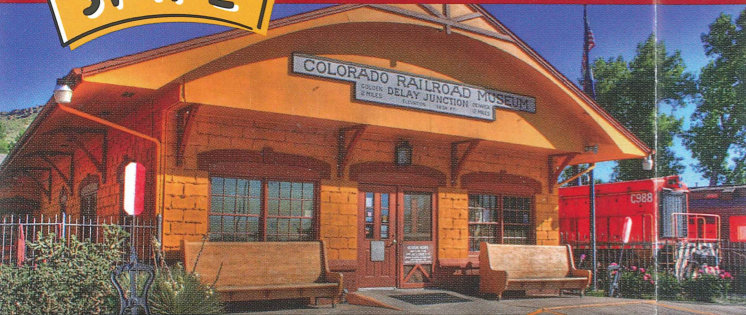




Welcome

DEPOT MUSEUM & EXHIBITS

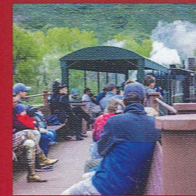

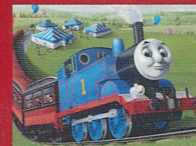
TRAIN RIDES

SPECIAL EVENTS

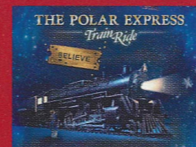
Holiday and seasonal trains, along with special rail-related events, highlight the Museum's annual timetable and include rides behind one of the Museum's steam or diesel engines.

YOUR ONCELL TOUR GUIDE

We have numerous tour stops around the rail yard. At these stops, you can use your cell phone to call 303-800-1303 and then enter the stop number. At that point, you will enjoy an audio recording that provides a description for that piece of equipment.

Look for this symbol  to take the OnCell Tour.*



Visitors with smartphones can simply snap a photo of the QR code with your QR reader. You will arrive at a mobile site that provides a description for that piece of equipment.

If you need help enabling your QR reader, please ask our guest services staff for assistance. Our rail yard is active and equipment can move to a new location. Ask a staff member if you cannot find the stop you are looking for!
