KEIKI (CHILDREN) ACTIVITIES Activities for children offered in every island. Look for this icon in each island.



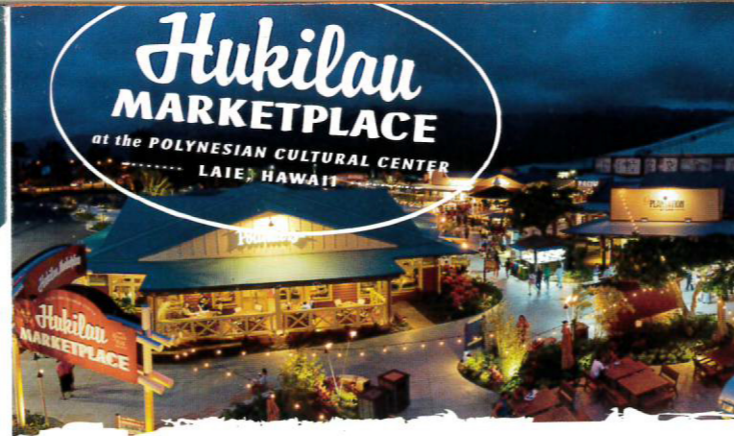
