

# Nature Play Opportunities

In accessing Tracy Aviary, visitors accept risks inherent in exploring our grounds and release Tracy Aviary of any claims for personal injury, illness, or property damage.

**A WOW Garden Trail** Explore the Wonders of Waterwise garden. Peek in on the dabbling ducks and the raptors on your way through. Hop across the rocks to ford the stream at the east side.

**B Teaching Stream Wetland** Take the all abilities pathway and find yourself surrounded by wetland plants such as milkweed, dogbane, rushes, and sedges.

**C Sensory Secret Garden** Listen, smell, look, and feel nature all around you. This trail is in a quiet corner of the Aviary great for practicing observation and contemplation skills.

**D Upper Teaching Stream** Head upstream to find more plants and animals that call this habitat home. Float a nature-made boat, or watch for native birds bathing in the stream.

**E Owl Forest Fort** Get a bird's eye view out of the fort. How many owl silhouettes can you see from your perch? Slow down and quiet your mind, can you see more now?

**F Fallen Logs** Play abounds in this open naturalistic play space. Climb on top of a fallen log and practice your stealthy bird viewing skills from the bird blind.

**G Sycamore Stream** Splash in the stream's water, as it flows through the rocks and plants. Turn over a rock and see what insects call it their home.

**H Dry Creek Bed** Winding trails take you through a landscape designed to attract wildlife. With lots of spots to sit and contemplate your surroundings on the way, this is a popular spot for squirrels and all kinds of other wildlife.

**I Water Sluice** Send water flowing into troughs and help it make its way to the drain. The sand is great for toddlers to dig right in.

**J Utah Discovery Garden** Hop from stump to rock and run in the grass in this active play area. Many of the plants surrounding this area are native to Utah. Do you recognize any of them from a visit to the canyons surrounding Salt Lake? Perhaps you'll see them on your next trip to the mountains.

**K Bird Feeder Climbing Wall** Work up an appetite traversing the wall. Make up your own route, challenge yourself and your friends to only use certain colors of holds. Build skills ahead of your next climbing adventure.

**L Nesting Grounds** Bird nests come in all shapes and sizes. Ground nests, cavity nests, and hanging nests are kid sized in this play area.

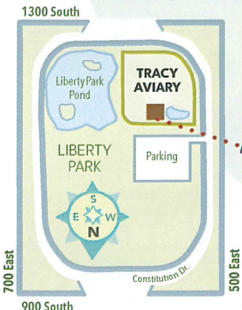

- 1 Treasures of the Rainforest** Transport yourself from Utah's arid desert landscape into a free-flight rainforest exhibit filled with colorful, boisterous birds.
- 2 Hawks and Turkey Vultures** Catch an up-close glimpse of hawks and vultures – Utah's airborne hunters and scavengers.
- 3 Kennecott Wetland Immersion Experience** Walk inside a Utah wetland and see dozens of native birds like white-faced ibis and black-crowned night herons.
- 4 Owl Forest** Step into a coniferous forest and gaze into the eyes of nocturnal silent hunters.
- 5 Lorikeet Adventure** Become part of the flock and come nose-to-beak with our lorikeets as you feed them.
- 6 Macaws and King Vultures** Delight in the colors and sounds of tropical parrots on one side and the equally colorful but less vocal king vultures on the other side.
- 7 South American Pavilion** Find toco toucans, blue-crowned motmots, scarlet ibis, and more in this collection of seven exhibits featuring birds and plants of South America.
- 8 Outdoor Bird Show Theater** Get up-close-and-personal with our most talented birds and their trainers.
- 9 Destination Argentina** Explore the birds of Argentina, from flamingos to the songbirds of an Argentine backyard.
- 10 Sunning Yard West and Sandhill Cranes** See the Bird Show Stars soak up the sunshine and visit the tallest birds in North America – a Utah native!
- 11 Southern Ground Hornbills** Enjoy the antics of our engaging and playful hornbills.
- 12 Expedition Kea** Find mischievous kea from New Zealand, laughing kookaburra from Australia, a bearded barbet from Africa, and a radiated tortoise from Madagascar.
- 13 The Bird Feeder Café** Migrate over to fill your bill with food and drinks, hot or cold.
- 14 Eagle Ridge** Pledge your allegiance to one of North America's largest raptors.
- 15 Sunning Yard North** Once home to Andy N. Condor, a long-time and incredibly impactful ambassador for vultures, this exhibit now features a rotating cast of his fellow Bird Show Stars!
- 16 Pelican Pond** Check out the pelicans and see for yourself if their bills can hold more than their bellies can. Enjoy the diversity of diving ducks and cormorants on the pond.
